RE: Application of the Charge Scale of the Cameroonian Professional Chamber of Technical Surveyors

Dear Sirs, dear Colleagues

It has come to my attention that some of our members do not respect the Professional Chamber's charge scale for unavowed reasons.

I am therefore taking this opportunity to remind you that, according to the law applicable to our sector of activity, the strict application of this charge scale is mandatory for all technical survey appointments.

For obvious reasons, the bodies responsible for supervising our profession and the State's fiscal services are adamant that the terms of the agreement which was validated by our General Assembly in accordance with Law no. 90/037 of 10 August 1990 must be respected.

All failures in the strict application of these instructions will expose you to the sanctions in force at the Professional Chamber and at the Inland Revenue in the form of highly justified tax adjustments.
