

PORT OF MARSEILLES FOS ACTIVITY CONTINUITY [COVID-19]

The President of the Republic and the French Government have announced measures to prevent the spread of Covid-19. The Port of Marseille Fos is a designated "Operator of Vital Importance" (OIV). As a strategic European supply point, it will ensure business continuity in strict compliance with health security instructions.

✓ Business continuity

Port services, the Harbour Master's Office and port operations continue to work in the eastern and western harbours. An adjustment to the organisation of the work is being implemented as of today to ensure the sustainability of operations.

The Harbour Master's Office works in close collaboration with the ship's services to coordinate the arrival of ships.

✓ Tighter health security measures

The Port applies all the health regulations issued by the Regional Health Agency (ARS) for all ship's passengers and crew members.

All the measures taken will ensure safe and secure logistics and industrial operations.

✓ Appropriate arrangements

A week ago, the Port's management set up a crisis unit to deploy the Activity Continuity Plan. For its staff and in accordance with instructions, the Port of Marseilles Fos has taken measures to ensure activity continuity, including the continuation of its essential missions.
